INTERNATIONAL PROGRAM FEATURES

For the **International Undergraduate Program** it is **mandatory** an international experience in an Exchange Erasmus Program of at least one semester abroad.

Students finish their bachelor when they reach the **minimum of 180 ECTS**, fullfilling the following criteria

Pass all mandatory courses of their study plan; Approval in all Lean in Action Program ECTS; Do all the remaining ECTS in elective courses or in optional validation, such as summer courses or experience validation.
